Did you know...?

- I can hear you from about 16 weeks and can hear your heartbeat and noises outside of your body by about 23 weeks

- I talk to myself lots when I am playing. This is where I am practicing using language

Planning a pregnancy

If you are thinking about having a baby, it may help to talk to your GP or visit the Tommy's National Centre for Maternity Improvement for health information and advice.

When you first come home with your baby

Your health visitor will offer support, advice and a general health and wellbeing check-up for you and your baby.

Dad Matters Calderdale is a local organisation which exists to support dads to have the best possible relationship with their families.

Register your child's birth within 42 days.

When your baby is 8 – 12 weeks old

Ask your local Family Hub about a home visit to introduce you to their activities or baby stay and play groups.

There are lots of activities taking place in your local community to support you, your baby and your wellbeing, where you can meet other families.

Vaccinations are offered to your baby at 12 weeks.

Antenatal – during pregnancy

Your midwife antenatal screening and health visitor will give you lots of advice and resources to help you prepare for your baby's birth.

You may wish to talk to a breastfeeding peer supporter too.

Mums should get their whooping cough vaccination at 16 weeks.

When your baby is 6 – 8 weeks old

Your health visitor will offer further support and advice and your GP will perform a routine check-up on you and your baby.

Vaccinations are available to your baby at 8 weeks.

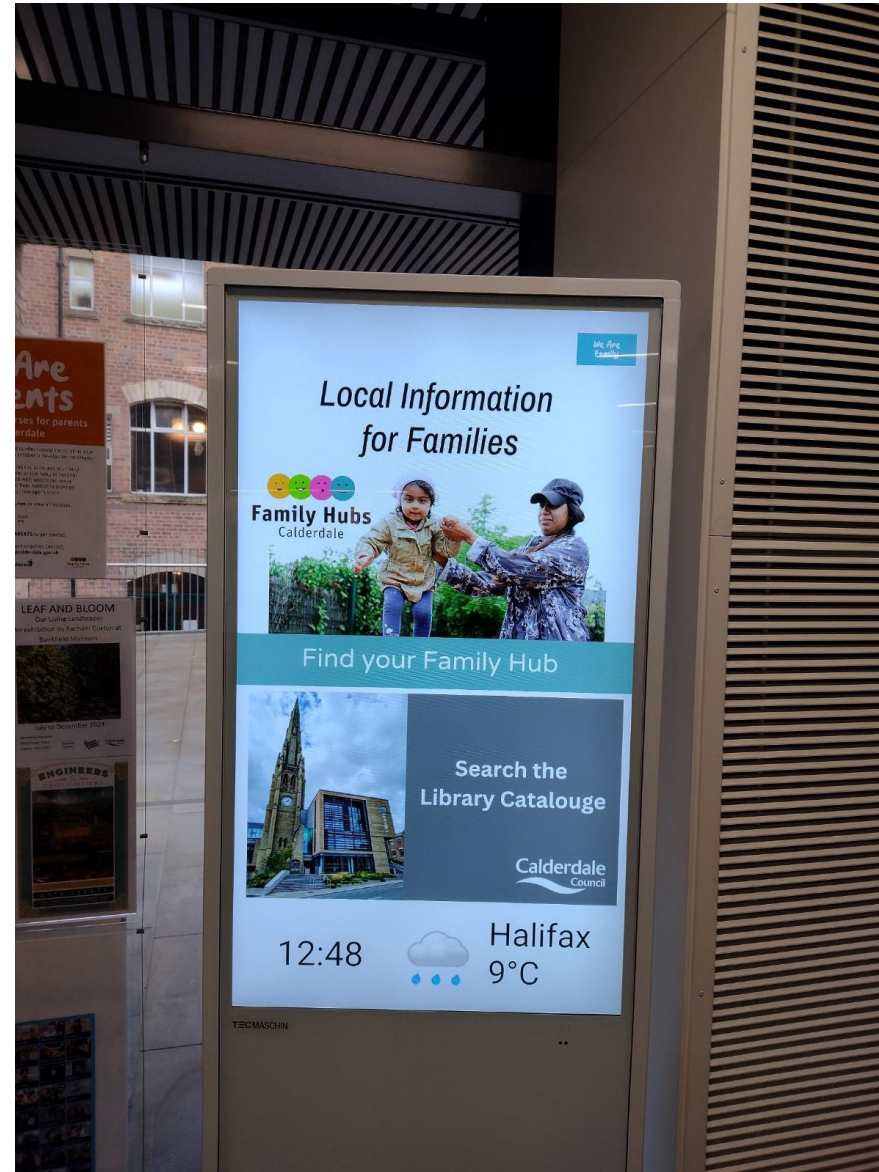

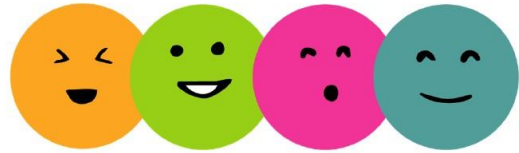
