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Family Hubs: What this means for Calderdale



- Govt. funding for the **Start for Life Family Hubs programme** to co-design, test and refine new ways of working (*until* Mar 25)
- Commitment to whole-system transformation to embed the **Family Hubs concept** as *the* Calderdale approach to joining up support for babies, children, young people and families (*from* Mar 25)

Taking the best of Sure Start and building on it:

- Increased focus on how services feel from the **families' perspective**
- A **virtual and digital** offer for the 21st century
- Going beyond buildings, **reaching into communities** post-Covid
- Increased focus on co-location and **multi-agency working**
- Expanding the **age range** to a conception-19 (or 25 with SEND) offer
- Integrating with **wider programmes** e.g. Supporting Families A commitment to a **universal** offer of help, support and information

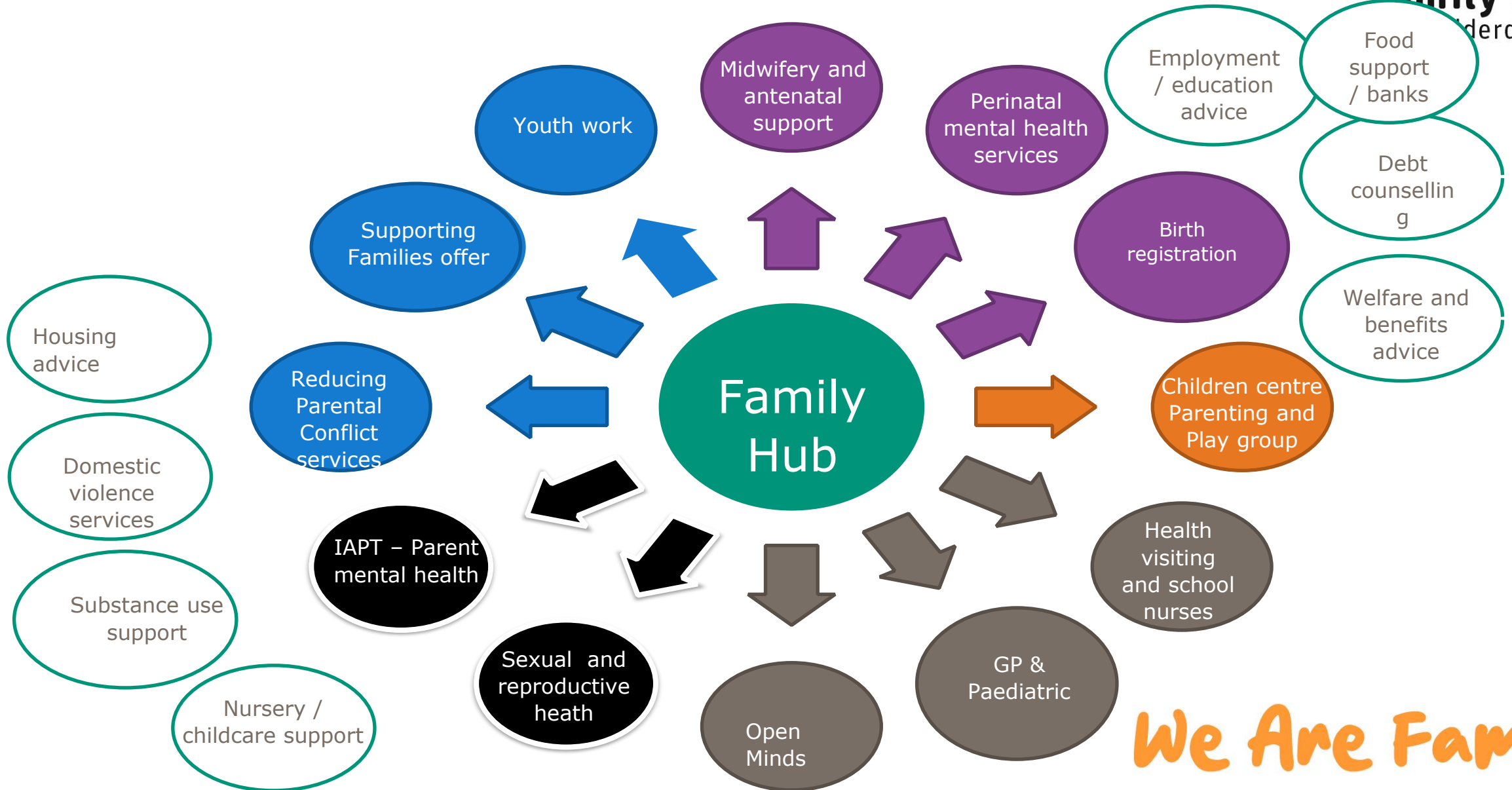

Family Learning is delivered across North Halifax, Lower Valley, Central Halifax, Upper Calder Valley, Calder and Ryburn, which includes accredited learning.

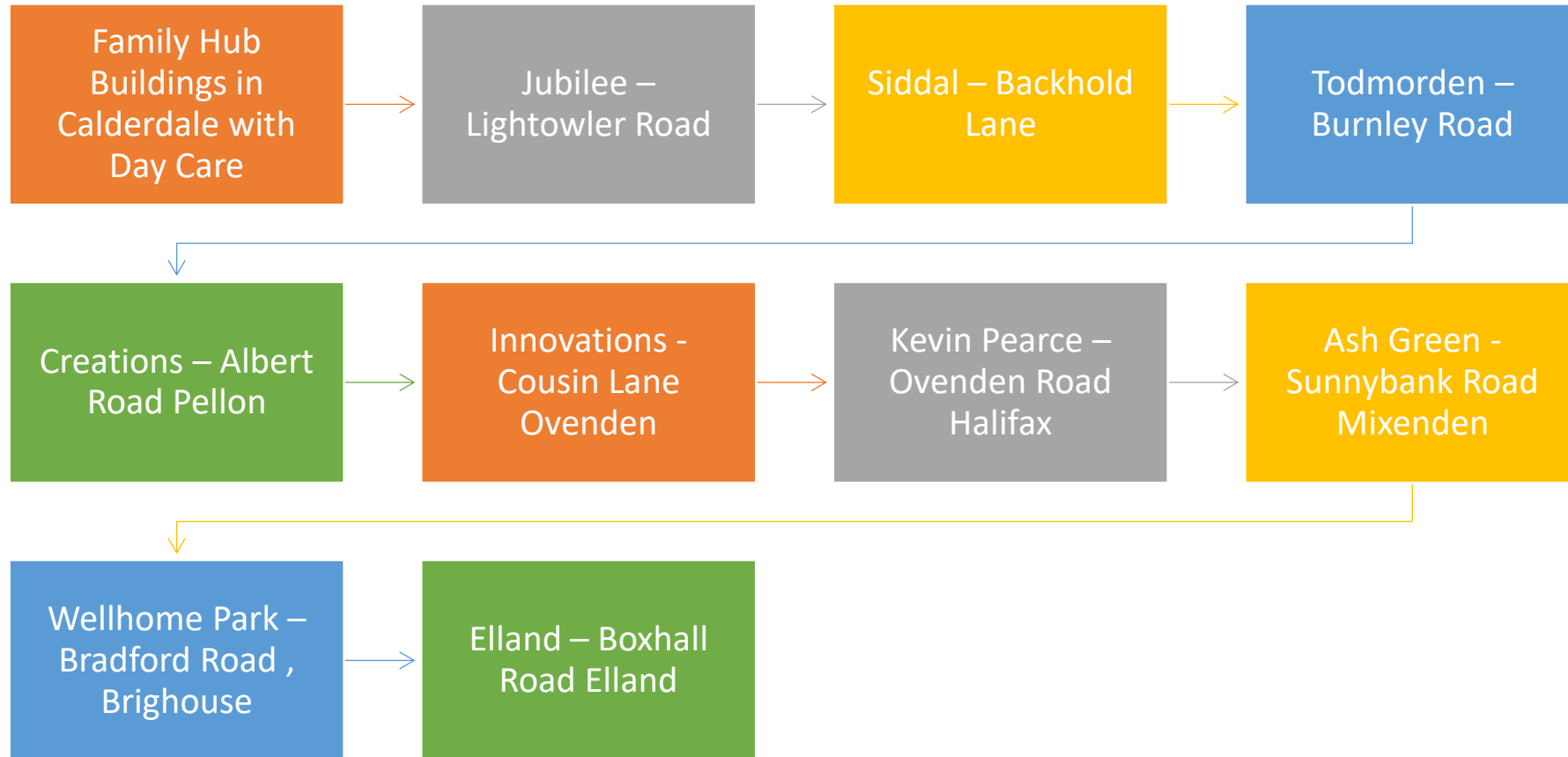
